

**Troop 535 Alternate Leadership Project
For Fulfillment of Star Rank Leadership Requirement**

Satisfactory completion of the following during a consecutive six-month period will be considered as fulfilling the leadership requirement for Star Scout.

Training: You must attend the troop Junior Leader Training even if you have attended in the past.

Attendance: You are expected to attend 80% of all troop meetings and participate in at least 50% of all troop outings, and service projects. Set the example by being an active Scout. Be on-time for meetings and activities. You must call your Patrol Leader if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing

Uniform: Set the example by wearing your uniform correctly. This means that you will wear all of the parts of the troop uniform, shirttail tucked in, with all required badges in their correct locations.

Behavior: Set the example by living the Scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show Scout Spirit in everything you say and do.

Service Project: With the approval of the Scoutmaster and the PLC you must plan, organize and lead at least one service project. This project can be for your community, your church, your school or for the troop. The service project should be for two or more hours and have at least 8 scouts participating.
